Join us for a crash-course in end-times prophecy with Pastor Tim Fellure. There will be two sessions nightly. A nursery will be provided.

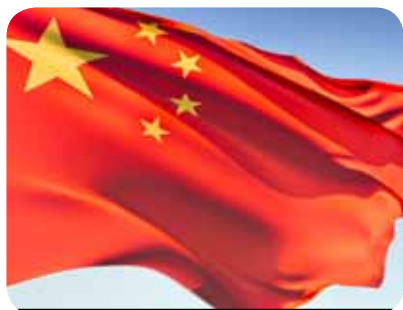


Pancake Supper February 12 at 6pm

Teacher's Corner

Tip #28: Help Nurtures Hope

"He restoreth my soul: he leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake."

- Psalm 23:3

When the child knows the instructor's main interest is helping him become what he should, the response of the student will inevitably be affected.

The student needs to understand that the primary goal of the instructor is to help and to guide the student along a path that will bring growth. The Bible analogy is that of a shepherd who cares for his flock. The shepherd knows his flock. The shepherd knows when a sheep is missing. The shepherd is willing to go far beyond the "norm" to help that lost sheep make it. There should never be a doubt that the shepherd cares for the flock.

The instructor is there to help, encourage, and preserve. A student must understand and unquestionably realize that the instructor has the student's best interests at heart.

Finally, the student will understand that it is the dream-the hope- of the instructor to see the student enter the harvest fields of the Lord Jesus Christ.
